Code Red Emergency Notification System

In light of the recent Boil Water Order, we would like to remind our residents of the Code Red Emergency Notification System. Although we do use other mass communication methods in the event of an emergency, Code Red is the ONLY way for us to notify you directly. Hence, it is very important for you to opt in to this system.

This system is also used for sever weather notifications. You are able to select what type of weather notifications you would like to receive: tornado, severe thunderstorm and/or flash flood. The weather notifications are sent out by the National Weather Service and you will only receive notification when the address you register is within the warning area. Please note that you will not receive weather notifications unless you optin to receiving these notifications. You also have the ability to receive notifications via text message or email.
