Protect Yourself This Mosquito Season

As we enter mosquito season, we would like to remind you that taking some simple precautions can help you avoid mosquito bites.

- 1. Use Insect Repellent** - when used as directed, EPA-registered insect repellents are proven safe and effective, even for pregnant and breastfeeding women. Avoid using highly perfumed soaps and shampoos and wear loose fitting clothing.
- 2. Take Steps to Control Mosquitoes Inside & Outside Your Home** - use screens on windows and doors, repair holes in screens, use air conditioning when available and once a week empty and scrub items that hold water, such as tires, buckets, planters, toys, pools, birdbaths, flowerpots or trash containers. Fans are a good way to keep mosquitoes off your deck or patio because they are weak fliers.
