Director of Public Works, Tim Birk stated the sewer lining would be used entirely in the Lou Del Subdivision this year as there is a lot of infiltration in that area and the price was lower due to the concentration of work at only one location. Mr. Birk also noted that Insituform has the original patent on sewer lining. Alderman Hopkins inquired as to the start time and length of project. Tim Birk stated that they are scheduled to begin around the first of September and it should be completed in approximately six (6) weeks. Motion passed unanimously with Aldermen Trantham, Darter, Frederick, Koerber, Heller, Notheisen, Thomas and Hopkins voting yea.
