- Water leaks:
  - a) Villas will be fixed by the end of the week
  - b) Quail Ridge leak was found by the farmer, supplies water to Remington Ridge and Sewer plant
  - c) Charles Sullivan had a leak in his home and needed water turn off while repairs are being made. The city discovered the need to replace water connection at the curb.
- Dairy Queen owes the city utility bill of \$13,600. There have been problems with the payment of utilities from the time the business opened. The mayor suggested disconnecting the water after giving a notice of our intent to the business. The service will not be restored until payment is made.
