The City of Waterloo has launched a new online billing and payment solution, offering more ways to view and pay your utility bill, plus the addition of 24/7 phone payments and pay by text. Residents can receive and view bills electronically, make a payment with credit/debit card or e-check, and choose to go paperless. A quick, one-time payment can be made without registering or you can create an account to enjoy more features like setting up automatic payments, saving payment information for later use and viewing history. - Registration is not required
- Go Paperless – get your bills via email
- Save time with automatic payment options
- Receive email reminders when your bill is ready, when a scheduled payment is pending, and a confirmation after making a payment
- Pay by Phone – check your account balance or make a payment 24/7 by calling 855-394-0772
- Pay by Text – get text notifications about your bill and have the option to pay through text message with your default payment method
