IMPORTANT UPDATES ON PAYMENT OPTIONS

The City of Waterloo has transitioned to a new online billing and payment portal, Invoice Cloud, which may be accessed through the City's website, www.waterloo.il.us/bill-payment. This portal offers customers the ability to view, print, and pay your utility bill with various payment options. Please remember payments are due on the 5th of each month. Payments made using Invoice Cloud must be made prior to 12:00 am (midnight) on the 5th to be considered on time.

Illinois E-Pay, the previous payment portal, will not be available after October 15, 2024.

The City's Direct Debit program remains unchanged and customers currently enrolled in the program do not need to do anything. This payment option is available free of charge.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF PAINT PROPERLY

Don't make your old paint someone else's problem by dumping it in a dumpster or your garbage bin. If the paint is water- or latex-based paint, you may dispose of it **after you dry it out**. Here are a few ways to harden paint so it's safe to throw away:

- Let the open paint sit out in the sun for a few days.
- Buy a paint hardener at the hardware store.
- Add mulch, kitty litter or sawdust until the paint hardens.

Oil-based paints are a toxic hazard, and should NEVER be put in the trash.
