- 2. Sidewalk Projects The state of Illinois is giving Waterloo a Rebuild Illinois Bond for \$716,639 to be used on IDOT approved projects. The City of Waterloo will receive the funds in six payments over the course of the next three years. Tim Birk recommended using the Rebuild Illinois Bond for phase five and phase six of the North Moore street project. Steve Notheisen made the motion, Clyde Heller seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- 3. Tornado Siren The Tornado siren at the high school is no longer functioning. It had been moved from a previous location. Tim Birk estimated that it is around 50 years old. Rich Scott presented the council with two bid options. After discussion with the council members it was decided Rich Scott would go back to the manufacturer and get a couple different options to present to the committee. The committee wanted more information on the level of decibels the different models would produce.
- 4. West Lake Dam The West Lake Dam Homeowner's Association completed work on the dam that was preventing it from being overlayed. The City took out a tandem truck and identified another soft spot on the shoulder. At this time the Committee is going to reach out to the HOA President along with the engineer they used to come up with a workable solution.
