- 1. Petitions by Citizens on Non-Agenda Items None
- 2. Dusk-to-Dawn Lighting Ordinance The City of Waterloo has a number of dusk to dawn lights that are on private property. The owners of the private property pay the city an amount of money that is added to their utility bill each month. It isn't completely consistent from light to light and the lights have all been updated to LED over the last 20 years. The LED lights are more energy efficient. Ordinance 38-1-38 is proposed to be updated to take out the language that is pertaining to all the old type of light bulbs and the proposed update is to add "LED Lighting fixtures under 149 Watts hall have a monthly charge of \$10 per month per fixture and will be added to the customer's monthly electric bill and shall become an integral part of said bill for a minimum two year period. LED fixtures with 150 watts or above will have a monthly charge to be determined by the Electric Department, at the time of the application, for a two year minimum period." Alderman Gary Most made a motion to recommend the update to the council from the committee. Alderman Jim Hopkins seconded the motion. All committee members in agreement. Motion accepted.
- 3. Comments Water Plant update Pressure test on the complete water line from the wells to the plant and from the plant to the tower have been completed and passed. Chlorine will be pushed through the line next week.
